✚ SYNOPSIS

The 3rd EMRS National Sports Meet was organized by National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS), an autonomous organization under Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA) from 17th December to 22nd December, 2022 at Vijayawada & Guntur, Andhra Pradesh. The 6 days' magnanimous sports event was hosted by Andhra Pradesh Tribal Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society (APTWREIS) at Indira Gandhi Stadium Vijayawada, Acharya Nagarjuna University, Guntur & Andhra Loyola College, Vijayawada. It was a massive ceremony in which **around 4300 Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS) students from across the country came together to promote the spirit and culture of Games & Sports in young children. Around 22 events (Individual and Team) took place during the six-day meet, from athletics and shooting to Kabaddi and Football etc.**

This magnificent event holds immense significance for NESTS as it is NESTS' first year of holding the mega-event and third for the Ministry.
