

Subject: Observing World Sickle Cell Disease Awareness Day on 19th June, 2024 in EMRSsreg.

As you are aware that the sickle cell gene is prevalent among many tribal population groups in India, leading to a weakened immune system and medical complications at a later stage. This genetic disorder significantly impacts a considerable portion of the ST community in India.

To effectively prevent and manage Sickle Cell Disease, it has been decided that screening tests shall be conducted in 25 selected EMRSs on 19th June, 2024 (as listed in *Annexure-I*), to mark World Sickle Cell Disease Awareness Day. This initiative would not only facilitate the early identification of sickle cell cases among these students but also ensure prompt medical intervention, if necessary.

Further, it has also been decided that by 15th November 2024, which marks the birth anniversary of Bhagwan Birsa Munda and also celebrated as the annual Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas, all functional EMRSs as well as 25% of the PVTG population will be screened.

Additionally, it is essential that each school designates one nodal teacher or hostel warden for the disease, specifically for students who test positive, to maintain constant contact, help them understand the disease, act as the first point of contact for any symptoms, and take care of them within the EMRS premises.

In view of the above, it is requested to designate one nodal teacher/hostel warden in each EMRSs to provide a conducive school environment for students who may be diagnosed with the disease. Additionally, for better management and control of the Sickle Cell Disease, an awareness and capacity-building event will be organized for the EMRS Principals and nodal teachers/hostel wardens on 20/06/2024 or 21/06/2024. In this regard, you are requested to kindly take necessary action.

Looking forward to your support and coordination.

Dear Ageet,

As you are aware, the World Sickle Cell Disease Awareness Day falls on 19th June every year. During this year, this Ministry has proposed that the EMRS students would be screened for the disease, since they fall within the category of population covered under the Mission for Elimination of Sickle Cell Disease. It has been proposed that screening in at least 25 EMRSs may be covered on 19th June. 2024.

In addition, it has also been decided that all the functional EMRSs as well as 25% of the PVTG population would be screened by 15th November, 2014, which is the birth anniversary of Bhagwan Birsa Munda and celebrated as the annual Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas.

Further, it may be noted that in the case of students who test positive for the disease or who are with the SCT (Sickle Cell Trait), there is a need for the concerned school authorities to be aware of the protocol of handling such students. Hence, it is essential that each of the schools designate a nodal teacher (s)/hostel warden for the disease. The number of such teachers may be decided by the NESTS/EMRS concerned. This nodal person shall be in constant contact with the student, enable him/her to understand the disease, be the first point of contact in case the student exhibits any symptoms and generally be the mentor and non-medical care provider for the student during his/her stay in the EMRS.

Keeping the above in view, the NESTS is requested to furnish the plan of action (i) for screening the 25 EMRSs on 19th June, 2024, and (ii) for the screening of students in all the functional EMRSs by 15th November, 2024, i.e. by Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas, 2024.
