Students are to create paintings that focus on core messages required for achieving the goals of Swachh Bharat Mission 2024. The suggestive core messages may include- 'Swabhav'/behaviour, 'Sanskar' (values), 'Zimmedari' (responsibility), and 'Bhaagidari' (collective participation). To be undertaken by all students studying from class 6 th to 12 th .
2.	18th September 2024	Swachhta Ouiz	Focus on cleanliness and hygiene.	 Quiz competitions testing students' knowledge and awareness about cleanliness and sanitation may be organized. School level, inter section competition may be organized Class wise Group activity for lower classes.

Every student of EMRS shall plant one tree in his/her mother's name and shall take care of the plant for the period he/she is studying in the school. Example- 6th Standard student shall take care of the plant till he/she is studying in the school and similarly. The plantation drive shall include variety of trees which are beneficial for ecosystem and school children.
