SECTION A

Objectives:

This event is organized by NCERT to give students the opportunity to understand and celebrate cultural diversity at the school, district, state, and national level. It shall be conducted at EMRS State level, EMRS National Level and National Level. The students selected at EMRS National Level shall get a chance to perform at National Level.

Note:

- 1. Junior group refers to the students of Class VI to VIII and Senior group refers to Class IX to XII.
- 2. This is the maximum size of the contingent. A State may send a small contingent and opt for participation in a few activities.
- 3. No additional participants are allowed solely for providing background music during the group dance. If required, participants from the instrumental music or group song categories within the contingent may be considered for providing background music.
- 4. There can be some common participants. The schedule will not be altered to accommodate these common participants. Hence it is advised to give maximum exposure to EMRS students in this fest.
- 5. Teacher Participants shall have to perform the duties of Escort too.
- 6. In Kala Utsav, one student can participate only in one art category, in the given year.
- 7. All /UT EMRS Societies are requested to encourage active participation of all categories of Children with Special Needs students.
- 8. Participating teachers shall be considered as escort also.
- 9. To reflect gender balance, States/ UTs shall strive to maintain an equal ratio of boys to girls in participation at events, wherever possible, especially Kala Utsav.
- 10. Each contingent must carry its own musical equipment for events such as Vocal Music, Instrumental Music etc., as no musical equipment will be provided in the National Level, by the organizers.

SECTION D

General Guidelines for EMRS NATIONAL CULTURAL & LITERARY FEST AND KALA UTSAV 2024

Level of Competitions

EMRS Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024 shall be organized at 2 levels viz. State level and National level.

State Level EMRS CULTURAL & LITERARY FEST AND KALA UTSAV 2024:

- i. The State/ UT EMRS Societies will conduct the State Level EMRS Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav as per the guidelines issued for EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024.
- ii. The selected students of the State Level EMRS Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav will participate in the EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024.
- iii. A pre- National Camp may be organized for the students selected for EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024 at EMRS/ State Level. Eminent Artist/Resource Persons from reputed art & Culture organizations may be engaged to train students. The expenditure of the same shall be borne by EMRS/State society.
- iv. Participating students will be duly escorted by the teachers/ Staff (Male &Female). It is pertinent to mention here that the Girls shall be escorted by only female staff and Boys by only male staff. Number of escorts to participants shall not exceed the ratio of 01:10 i.e. there shall be one escort for 10 girls/ boys. If the number exceeds 10, then 01 more escort is to be appointed.
 - While selecting the escorts, care should be taken, 'NOT' to depute those teachers who are medically unfit/ under treatment/ physically challenged. Female Staff having child below 3yrs, should usually not to be deputed as escort. Participating teachers shall be considered as escort also.
- v. Reservations of the selected participants for EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024 is to be made immediately after the State Level EMRS Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav. Ensure the journey of the participants of EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024 on confirmed seats/berths.

SECTION E

<u>Details of the events for EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest</u> and Kala Utsav 2024

Cultural Events

Group Song:

Duration of the Group Song will be 4-5 minutes including the announcement. The number of participants allowed on the stage will be 04 (four) with 04 (four) persons including the Music Teacher for background music. No person from outside EMRS will be allowed to play/sing. Group Song under the Patriotic category shall be in Hindi, however a few verses in Sanskrit are also allowed. **The participating contingent from each State/UT is responsible for bringing their own instruments for background music.**

Group Dance:

Group Dance to be presented by the State/ UT EMRS Society must be related to the **tribal dance of the State.** Maximum time allowed for the dance will be 06 (six) minutes including the announcement. Total number of participants allowed are 08 + 01 music teacher. Depending upon the tribal dance, either all the 08 (eight) can be on stage or some of them can be used for background music. Music teacher is allowed to participate either for providing background music or playing of some instrument. No extra participant on the context of providing background music for group dance is allowed. No person from outside EMRS will be allowed to play/sing. **Pre-recorded cassette or any other recorded device will not be allowed**. The group dance will be performed in the tribal costumes of the State. **The musical instruments required for performing the main activity shall be arranged and brought by the contingent of the State/UT.**

Solo Song:

Semi- Classical song will include Gazals & Bhajans. The State/ UT EMRS Society must ensure that the lyrics and presentation is decent. The participant may be provided background musical accompaniment by up to 03 (three) persons including the music teacher but the accompanists should be from the participants already elected for other activities of EMRS National Cultural Fest & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024. No additional participants should be selected specifically as accompanist. Maximum time allowed is 5 (five) minutes including the announcement. The musical instruments required for performing the main activity shall be arranged and brought by the contingent of the State/UT.

On-the-Spot Painting:

Theme for the On-the-spot Tribal Painting Competition shall be contemporary issues related to Nature, Environment, Social Issues, Celebrations etc. The maximum time allotted is 90 (ninety) minutes. The participants shall have to bring colors and other accessories whereas sheets shall be provided by the host venue.

Instrumental:

The instrumental competition will include tribal musical instruments being used by the tribes of the State/ UT. Only 02 (two) participants are allowed on the Stage. These participants can, however, play more instruments if so desired by them. The musical instruments required for performing the main activity shall be arranged and brought by the contingent of the State/UT.

Maximum time allowed is 06 (six) minutes including the announcement.

Literary Fest

Elocution:

The topic of Elocution for EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024 is:

Senior Group: "The Future of Biofuels- Innovations, Potential and Challenges."

The topic shall be same for State Level EMRS Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav. Each State/ UT EMRS Society shall select 2 participants in each group (1 for Hindi & 1 for English) to participate at National Level. The topic for Hindi & English Elocution are same. The elocution timings are 03 (three) minutes for Junior group and 04 (four) minutes for Senior group.

Story Telling:

Story Telling will be in Hindi or English i.e. out of 02 (two) students one student will participate in Hindi and other in English story telling. Stories presented should be the tribal folklores of the State/UT. These stories must not touch on sensitive issues such as Race, Religion, Stereotyping, Politics etc. Props, Backdrops, and sound effects are not allowed. The duration of story shall not exceed 03 (three) minutes. Time limit shall be strictly enforced. Story must be memorized and not read. Hand movements and facial expression are allowed but dramatization is prohibited.

Language proficiency includes correct, clear, and accurate pronunciation, clear enunciation, and intonation, correct use of grammar, appropriate and effective choice of words, fluency of speech etc.

Presentation and delivery include voice modulation, voice projection and clarity. Themes/ Story lines include interest, appeal, significance, impact of meaning, coherence, and integrated values.

Extempore:

The competition will be in Hindi & English. One student will participate in Hindi & another in English. The theme will be disclosed on the same day of the competition. Time allowed is 02-03 minutes. Time limit shall be strictly enforced.

Spell Bee:

It is a competition of English word spelling. A screening test will be conducted at National Level and 4 top scoring teams will be selected for Final Spell Bee contest.

Whether 'One nation one election' will strengthen Indian economy and Democracy?

The topic shall be same for State Level EMRS Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav. Each State/UT EMRS Society will select two speakers one 'for' and the other 'against' the motion separately for Hindi and English. The debate will be of 05 (five) minutes duration of which minimum 01 (one) minute must be devoted to rebuttal and repartee i.e. every speaker shall be given 04 (four) minutes to present his/her view point on the topic and 01 (one) minute at the end shall be used for rebuttal and repartee.

The preliminary round will be a written round in which maximum two students from every State/ UT EMRS Society will participate. Four top scoring teams will qualify for the final round. The quiz will be verbal with audio & visual round.

Kala Utsav (Based on 2024 Guidelines)

Students declared winners in Kala Utsav in EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024shall get an opportunity to participate at National Level Kala Utsav competition organized by NCERT.

Instrumental Music-Percussive includes Indian musical instruments like – Mridangam, Edakka, Tabla, Dhol, Naal, etc. Instrumental Music- Melodic (any string or aerophone) instruments include Indian Melodic instruments like Violin, Sitar, Flute, Sarod, Veena, Shehnai, Santoor etc. The duration of the performance will be 4—6 minutes. Costumes and stage settings should relate to the presentation. Only indigenous musical instruments are allowed. Electronic or programmed musical instrument will not be allowed. The participant may be provided background musical accompaniment by up to 2 persons but the accompanists should be from the participants already selected for other activities of EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024. No additional participants should be selected specifically for the same. The musical instruments required for performing the main activity shall be arranged and brought by the contingent of the State/UT.

Dance:

The competition in Dance will be conducted in the following categories:

1. Dance — Classical (Solo)

Regional Folk Dance (Group)

Regional Tribal Dance (Group)

Classical dance forms include Bharatanatyam, Kathak, Sattriya, Kuchipudi, Odissi, Mohiniyattam, Kathakali, Seraikella Chhau and Manipuri. Traditional folk dance will be traditional folk of any State or region. Group dances can be in traditional folk forms. The duration of the performance will be 4–6 minutes. Music can either be recorded or played live. No extra participants will be allowed for live music. Costumes and make-up should be simple, authentic, thematic, and related to the presentation. Very simple and minimum sets, costumes, etc., are to be arranged by the teams. Sets/ props to be arranged by the respective State/ UT EMRS Society.

Visual Arts:

The competition in Visual Arts will be conducted in the following categories:

- 1. 2 Dimensional Visual Arts—Drawing, Painting, Printing, Cartoon and Caricature
- 2. 3 Dimensional Visual Arts Sculpture and Mobiles
- 3. Indigenous Toys and Games
- 4. Local Crafts

The competitions for Visual Arts will be held for 03 (three) days. The participants are expected to complete their art work on the spot during the national level competition. Artworks made earlier are not allowed. The size of 2D work will not be bigger than 2×3 ft. The size of the 3D work will not be bigger than $2 \times 2 \times 2$ ft. For Indigenous Toys and Games, the maximum number of toys will be 04 (four) only. Selection of the material and medium will be as per the choice of student. All the materials used for subcategories of Visual Arts should be eco-friendly and bio-degradable. In Indigenous Toys the participant is expected to focus on the functional accuracy and originalism of the toy(s) or game(s).

The arrangements of the art material should be made by the respective State/UT EMRS Societies or by the participants. The participants should be available at the venue for interaction with the jury. The jury will observe the participants during the process and interact with them on all days. Each of the participants for all the sub-categories of Visual Arts will be provided space of 6×4 ft to work. In Indigenous Toys the participant is expected to focus on the functional accuracy and original design of the toy(s) or game(s).

The duration of the performance will be 6 to 8 minutes. Every team will get additional 05 (five) minutes for the stage setting (technical setting and clearing of the stage).

Performance can be in language or dialect of your region. Costumes, stage-setting, props etc. will be arranged by the participant himself/ herself. For background music one may use tracks or recorded music.

Events for Teachers:

Music:

The competition is open for all categories of the teachers of EMRSs.

The theme would be Semi- Classical (Gazals, Bhajans and qawwali) and Classical (based on Ragas). The participant may be provided background musical accompaniment by up to 3 (three) persons but the accompanists should be from the participants already selected for other activities of EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala 2024. No additional participants should be selected specifically for the same. The musical instruments required for performing the main activity shall be arranged and brought by the contingent of the State/UT.

The instrumental competition will include any instruments such as Sitar, Flute, Guitar, Benzo, Harmonicas, Accordions, and Violin etc. for semi classical music. Percussion instruments can be used as accompanist only. The participants will be allowed to use 02 (two) accompanist students or teachers from the participants selected for other activities.

SECTION-F

SAFETY AND SECURITY MEASURES

- A 24-hour help desk should be available at stay venue so that students/ escort can
 contact them at any time in case of emergency/ any problem. The helpdesk staff
 should be equipped with the requisite facilities i.e., telephone/ mobile number
 attend to the participating teams, escorts & others. A Register should be
 maintained in which complaints are noted along with action taken and date and
 time of redressal.
- 2. Important Contact numbers must be displayed prominently on notice boards and other frequently used places and a copy should be given to all escort teacher.
- 3. Visitor register should be maintained at stay venue. Unwanted visitors must be prohibited at stay & competition venue. In case a child is expecting a visitor, the parent/ guardian of the child must have informed the escort and the Venue Principal along with the details of the visiting person beforehand. A visitor turning up suddenly to visit a child should not be permitted in the premises. A child should not be allowed to go out without escort and permission of the venue Principal. Escorts should have the telephone number of all the students under their care as well as their parents.
- 4. All safety measure should be in place viz. Fire safety, water tanks, septic tanks, drains and deep pits at the games and stay venue should be closed, terrace gate/doors must be locked, electrical switches, wires, electric points and appliances must be checked to avoid any untoward incidents. The stay venue should be fumigated and pest control measures be taken well before the reporting of the teams for EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024. The area should be cleaned and extra vegetation, grass, bushes etc. removed.
- 5. Cleanliness should be always ensured.
- 6. Surveillance System must be functional and adequate number of Security guard be deployed round the clock at Dining area, Common places and corridor etc.
- 7. Medical facilities /Medical assistance must be arranged at stay venue. In case of any emergency, nearby Hospital should be referred to immediately.
- 8. Only authorized persons should be allowed for video & photography during EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024.
- 9. Safe and secure transport should be arranged for the participating students & escort from stay venue to Competition venue & vice-versa.

SECTION - G

Guidelines for Expenditures

I. Expenditure by EMRSs

- (b) TA & DA for Journey period from School to the place of assembly of Contingent of the State/ UT EMRS Society for participation in EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024 and back.
- (c) Costumes for the events for State Level Cultural & Literary Fest / EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024.
- (d) Pre- National Camp, if required, for the students selected for EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024.

II. Expenditure by State/UT EMRS Society

The State/UT EMRS Society will make the following expenditure from the grants received from NESTS/MoTA as per the details-

- (a) Conduct of State Level Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav.
- (b) TA & DA for participating students & their escorts during the journey period from the place of assembly of Contingent of the State/ UT EMRS Society to the Venue of the EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024 and back.

Note- Food/Transportation bills during journey Period should not be insisted upon from escort teachers for State Level Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav / EMRS National Cultural & Literary Fest and Kala Utsav 2024. Self-Certified/ Verified bills should suffice.

III. Expenditure by NESTS/ MoTA
