CIRCULAR

Subject: Invitation to Hon'ble MPs/MLAs and other local dignitaries during major events in EMRSs – reg.

EMRSs across the country regularly organise important academic, cultural, and national events, such as Annual Day celebrations, Independence Day, Republic Day and, wherever applicable, State-level Sports Meets and State-level Cultural Meets.

2. These events play a vital role in instilling pride, confidence, and a sense of achievement among tribal students. They provide an important platform for students to showcase their talents in academics, sports, and cultural activities, thereby contributing to their holistic development.
3. The participation of senior public representatives and local dignitaries, such as Hon'ble Members of Parliament (MPs), Hon'ble Members of Legislative Assemblies (MLAs), District Collectors (DCs), and other senior officers, significantly enhances the importance of these occasions. Their presence serves as a source of motivation and inspiration for students and strengthens the institutional connect between EMRSs, local administration, and the community.
4. Accordingly, all EMRSs are advised to extend invitations to the highest local dignitaries, including Hon'ble MPs, MLAs, District Collectors, and other senior officials, for participation in the major events organised by the school.
5. The invitations may be extended well in advance, following due protocol.
